

Our programme covers every genre imaginable – from live music, spoken word, comedy and theatre in our performance spaces, to independent films and blockbusters across our three-screen cinema. Through our creative engagement programme, we transform the lives of young people, children and adults through creativity.

Located in the heart of Shoreditch, our landmark five-floor building offers a great variety of flexible workspaces and music, film and TV production studios at competitive commercial and charity rates.

Our workspaces are a blank canvas for your organisation – a place to host clients, hold meetings, produce work, and gather your team together in-person.

REIMAGINING RICH MIX

It's an exciting time to join us as a resident as we embark on the second phase of our Reimagining Rich Mix project, which looks to adapt our ground floor and yard.





Back in May 2022, we were delighted to announce that we were successful in our application to Arts Council England's Capital Investment Programme for the next phase of Reimagining Rich Mix – making the most of our building and giving people more ways to connect with us.

We want our building to be as inclusive and vibrant as we are, with an inviting welcome, sociable spaces, and places for creative chatter and collaboration – a meeting place for the cultures and communities of East London and beyond.

The first phase, completed in early 2022, redeveloped parts of our first floor – creating a Cinema Bar (perfect for meetings), dedicated Creative Engagement space The Lab, an artist green room and a visual arts gallery space.

Our proposals for the ground floor look to:

- © Create a new entrance on Redchurch Street, with a green area in our yard
- Improve our welcome for visitors and residents, and make it easier to navigate the space
- Improve our access for disabled visitors, residents and team members, including the creation of a Changing Places toilet
- © Create a new visual arts and community space, and area for eating and drinking

BEING A RICH MIX RESIDENT


Our building is home to more than 20 resident organisations, working in fields from theatrical production and contemporary art to lighting design, charitable work and music education.


Rich Mix Cultural Foundation was set up 'to work towards the elimination of racial discrimination' (taken from the charity's founding articles).

ENVIRONMENTAL SUSTAINABILITY AT RICH MIX


We recognise that as a community organisation, and as individuals, we have a responsibility to change our actions now so that we can have a cleaner, healthier future in our neighbourhood and the world.


